Calling all String players! Violist Leslie Johnson will present a 2-hour long Community Music Masterclass.

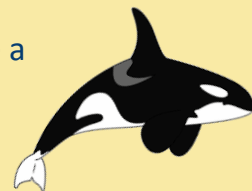

THURSDAY April 11, 2019

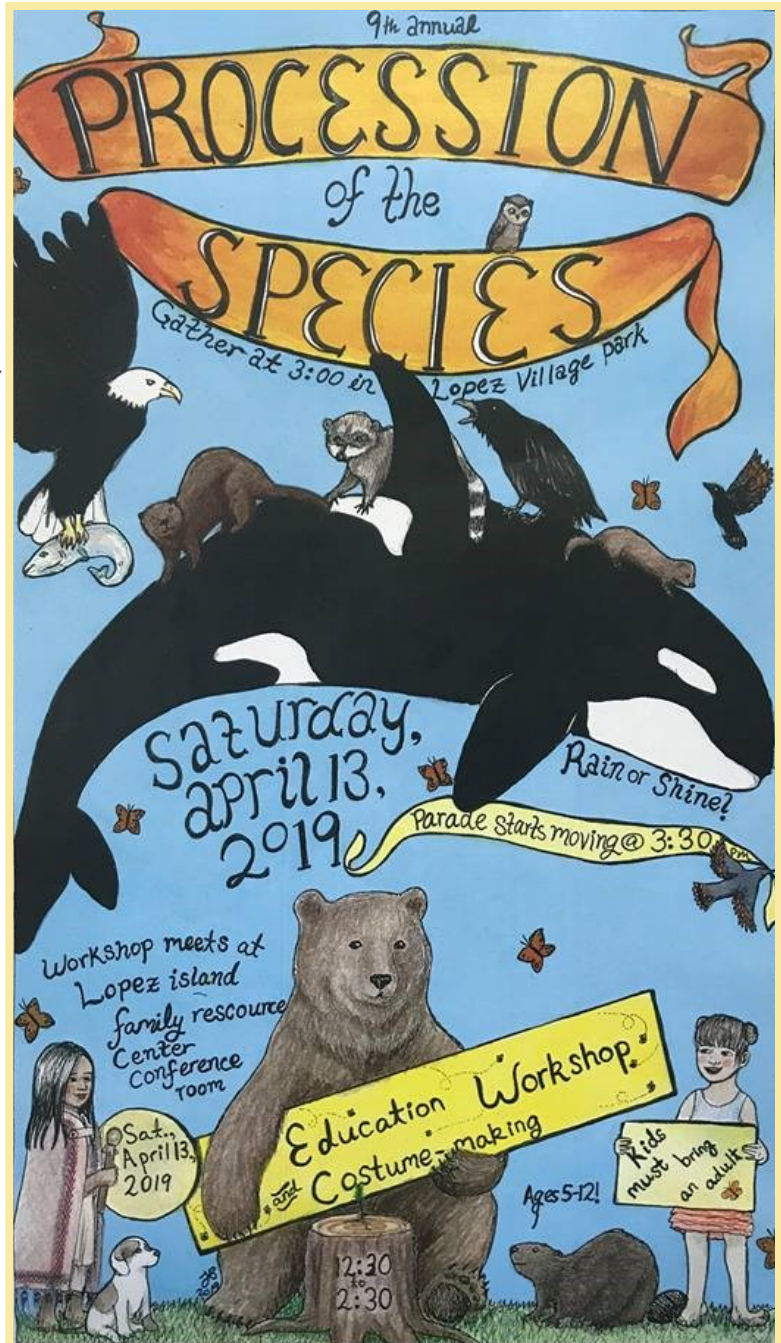
Lopez Garden Club– Fresh Cut Flowers 9:30am
